TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Safety Check	4/3/16	63 rd Avenue & Hwy 169 – report of two people sitting on the bridge; on arrival parties were standing at the railing and stated they were just talking.
Medical	4/3/16	7000 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – report of person possibly having diabetic reaction. Officers were cleared by paramedics.
Theft	4/4/16	9000 block of Dunkirk Lane – report of person taking items, concealing them and leaving business without paying for them; on arrival officers arrested person for shoplifting.
Theft	4/4/16	7000 block of Main Street – report of person taking speaker without paying; on arrival person not located and no suspects at this time.
Medical	4/4/16	11000 block of 88 th Place – report of person having high blood sugar; on arrival officers assisted paramedics getting person in ambulance and were cleared.

Suspicious Vehicle	4/5/16	9000 block of Pineview Lane – report of vehicle in front of residence for 45 minutes; officers made contact with person who had appointments in the area. No problems.
Damage to Property	4/6/16	7000 block of Main Street – report of damage to glass at Town Green stage; on arrival officers found heavy damage to stage area. Case under investigation.

Damage to Property	4/6/16	13000 block of Territorial Road – report of mailbox damaged; on arrival officers noticed mailbox in the ditch. So suspects at this time.
Theft From Auto	4/6/16	8000 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – report of purse stolen from unlocked vehicle in parking lot; no suspects at this time.
Prowler	4/6/16	10000 block of Pilgrim Lane – report of person wearing dark clothing sitting on porch of residence; when homeowners noticed; person ran; officers searched area and did not locate person.
Open Door	4/7/16	6000 block of Merrimac Lane – report of neighbor’s garage door open; on arrival found door open and notified homeowner. Nothing missing.
Theft	4/7/16	13000 block of Bass Lake Road – report of person who pumped gas and left without paying; officers searched area and were unable to locate vehicle.
Theft	4/7/16	13000 block of Grove Drive – report of person taking several items and leaving business without paying; on arrival officer’s located person and arrested them for theft and a warrant.
Burglary	4/8/16	7000 block of Vinewood Court – report of three suspects that opened front door and attempted to enter residence. When they noticed homeowner, they ran; officers set up perimeter, unable to locate suspects.
Theft From Auto	4/8/16	13000 block of 77 th Avenue – report of items stolen from unlocked vehicle in driveway; no damage to vehicle and no suspects.
Burglary	4/8/16	7000 block of Vinewood Court – report of garage door opener stolen from unlocked vehicle and garage door open; nothing stolen from inside garage, no suspects.
Fight	4/8/16	13000 block of 83 rd Way – report of 10 juveniles fighting in parking lot; on arrival parties advised they were “play fighting” and had caused no harm. No further action.
Damage to Property	4/9/16	90 th Place & Sycamore Lane – report of window broken out of excavator at construction site; no suspects.

Medical	4/9/16	12000 block of 63 rd Avenue – report of person with high blood sugar; on arrival monitored person until medics arrived for transport to hospital.
Damage to Property	4/9/16	9000 block of Hemlock Lane – report of window broken on vehicle parked in driveway overnight; nothing taken and no suspects.
