

## MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of January 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 through January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016. TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Appliance Fire	1/22/16	9200 block of Inland Lane – report of a fire in an oven; on arrival officer shut breaker off to oven and fire went out. Broken element caused fire. Fire department arrived and cleared officers.
Suspicious Activity	1/22/16	9700 block of Ives Lane – report of person crawling through a basement window; on arrival contact made with son of homeowner and his friend had crawled through the window.
Theft From Auto	1/22/16	16700 block of 94 <sup>th</sup> Avenue – report of license plate stolen off vehicle; officers learned that the missing plate had been used in a gas drive off without paying. No suspects at this time.
Medical	1/22/16	6200 block of Queensland Lane – report of person having difficulty breathing; on arrival officers provided oxygen until paramedics arrived and cleared officers.
Medical	1/23/16	9800 block of 69 <sup>th</sup> Avenue – report of person who had fallen. Person transported to hospital by ambulance.
Medical	1/24/16	8600 block of Valley Forge Lane – report of person fainting, officers monitor person until paramedics arrived for transport.
Theft From Auto	1/25/16	6800 Hemlock Lane – report of items stolen from inside unlocked vehicle in business parking lot; no suspects at this time.
Medical	1/26/16	16000 block of 70 <sup>th</sup> Place – report of person with severe pain. Transported to hospital by ambulance.
Mail Theft	1/26/16	8300 block of Arrowwood Lane – report of credit card payment taken out of mailbox and check cashed at nearby business; officers learned that a different agency had arrested parties with multiple stolen checks.

Theft of Gas	1/26/16	13000 block of Grove Drive – report of person putting gas in vehicle and leaving without paying; officers learned that plate was stolen out of another city.
Medical	1/26/16	14400 block of 91 <sup>st</sup> Place – report of person slipping on ice and knocked unconscious; on arrival officers assist paramedics in getting person into ambulance.
Theft	1/27/16	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of shoplifting taking place at business; on arrival officers located suspect vehicle and arrested parties for theft.
Shoots Fired	1/28/16	Area of Worden Park and Fish Lake – report of person walking dog on lake when a round from gun ricocheted off a shed and onto the lake about 30 feet in front of person; officers made contact with suspect who finally admitted to shooting a C02 BB gun at his shed. Person verbally warned of ordinance.

During this time period there were 30 property damage traffic accidents and two property damage injury traffic accidents.
