

## MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of March 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016 through April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016. TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Stolen Vehicle	3/27/16	12000 block of 70 <sup>th</sup> Avenue – report of unlocked vehicle with keys under seat stolen from driveway overnight; vehicle recovered in Minneapolis. Case being investigated.
Medical	3/27/16	8400 block of Revere Lane – report of person having seizure; person transported to hospital by ambulance.
Fire	3/27/16	7000 block of Birchview Road – report of smoke smell coming from residence; on arrival officers found no fire but burnt food from oven with plastic covering on it.
Suspicious Vehicle	3/28/16	15000 block of 105 <sup>th</sup> Avenue – report of suspicious vehicle pulling into owners driveway and when owner noticed outside and left in a hurry; vehicle not located.
Theft	3/28/16	8000 block of Revere Lane – report of several items of taken from yard area of business; no suspects at this time.
Theft	3/28/16	13000 block of Grove Drive – report of person taking items from store without paying and then assaulting a person; officers could not located suspect at the time.
Suspicious Vehicle	3/28/16	12000 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – officers noticed suspicious vehicle at business loading dock; when contact made persons were arrested for theft and warrants.
Vehicle Fire	3/29/16	16000 block of County Road 30 – report of flames coming from engine block of vehicle in parking lot; on arrival engine block engulfed in flames. Fire department arrived a put out fire; no injuries.
Medical	3/29/16	9000 block of Rice Lake Road – report of person possibly having a stroke; on arrival stood by until paramedics arrived and then cleared.

Suspicious Activity	3/29/16	7000 block of Ranchview Lane – report of hearing gun shots or very loud bang; officers arrived and did not locate anything unusual. Later reporting party called back stating it was a bicycle tire that exploded in the garage.
Medical	3/30/16	8000 block of Rice Lake Road – report of person falling and having difficulty breathing; on arrival administered oxygen until paramedics arrived for transport.
Theft	3/30/16	6000 Sycamore Lane – report of bicycle being stolen from outside of business; case being investigated for suspects.
Medical	3/31/16	13000 block of 83 <sup>rd</sup> Way – report of person having a diabetic incident while driving, hitting a car; on arrival car was in reverse, officer turned off vehicle. Medics arrived and cleared officers.
Theft	3/31/16	13000 block of Grove Drive – report of two suspects taking items from business without paying; on arrival officers made contact and arrested both parties. Merchandise returned.
Suspicious Activity	3/31/16	11000 block of Central Park Way – report of person in construction area taking wire from dumpster; on arrival officers met with crew cleaning up construction area.
Damage To Property	4/1/16	9000 block of Kirkwood Way – report of vehicle sunroof being smashed out; on arrival officers noticed what looked like a rock mark. No suspects at this time.
Medical	4/1/16	8000 block of Niagara Lane – report of unconscious person; on arrival person unresponsive but breathing. Officers cleared by paramedics.
Vandalism	4/1/16	8000 block of Tewsbury Gate – report of eggs being thrown at residence doing damage; no suspects at this time.
Suspicious Person	4/2/16	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of person trying to get into the wrong vehicle in parking lot; on arrival officers made contact with party in correct vehicle and arrested them for DWI.
Damage to Property	4/2/16	9000 block of Olive Lane – report of vehicle being damaged by landscaping rock; on arrival officers notice dents and scratches caused by rock. No suspects at this time.

Fire	4/2/16	12000 block of 63 <sup>rd</sup> Avenue – report of smoke coming from room in building and nobody answering door; on arrival made entry to room and found burnt food on stove, no fire.
Theft	4/2/16	13000 block of Grove Drive – report of person taking items, not paying for them and leaving business; officers could not locate suspect at this time.

During this time period there were 28 property damage traffic accidents and six property damage injury traffic accidents.
