Yes – Recycle These Items!

- Newspaper & Newspaper inserts
- Magazines & Catalogs
- All Junk Mail & Envelopes
- Cardboard (break-down boxes)
- Office & School Paper (all colors)
- Phone Books
- Cereal & Cracker-type boxes
- Brown paper sacks/bags
- Aluminum, Steel & Tin cans
- Glass bottles & Jars
- Plastics: #1 thru #7 – bottles, cups, plastic food containers, tubs, bowls, yogurt cups & margarine/whip cream tubs**
- Plastic milk jugs & Paper milk cartons
- Plastic bags (*place all bags in 1 bag inside the cart so they don't blow around*)
- Juice boxes & other paper cartons



No – Do Not Recycle These Items!

- No garbage
- No food waste
- No food-tainted items (used paper plates)
- No paper towels or paper napkins
- No pizza boxes
- No egg cartons
- No wax-coated cartons
- No ice-cream cartons
- No aluminum foil
- No Styrofoam cups/plates or packaging
- No aerosol cans, propane tanks or helium tanks
- No batteries
