

MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of July 17th, 2015 through July 23rd, 2015. Please refer to City Web-Site Crime Mapping Section for additional details for the crimes of Burglary, Robbery, Arson, Theft and Vehicle Theft.

TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Vandalism	7/17/15	9600 block of Zircon Lane – report of several residences being egged in area; officers viewed video and identified suspects. Case being investigated.
Theft	7/17/15	9500 block of Blackoaks Lane – report of stolen cell phone from table at business; officer viewed video and found employee took phone, but denied doing so. Case being investigated.
Theft	7/17/15	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of theft of merchandise from store; officers arrived and eventually located several suspects who were arrested for theft, drugs, false information to police and warrants.
Suspicious Activity	7/18/15	Hemlock Lane and I-694 – report of vehicle in ditch and person walking on freeway; on officers arrival driver located and arrested for DWI.
Vehicle Theft	7/18/15	8400 block of Underwood Lane – report of vehicle with trailer attached stolen; on arrival officers found glass in street, but no other evidence. Vehicle and trailer later recovered in other cities and case being investigated.
No Pay	7/19/15	Bass Lake Road and Lawndale Lane – report of person jumping out of taxi and not paying for fare; officers located female who was very hostile with officer but finally did go back and pay taxi fare.
Animal Complaint	7/19/15	9400 block of Dunkirk Lane – report of dogs left in vehicle in 86 degree temperature for 50 minutes; on arrival officer cited owner for mistreat of animal.
Discharge Weapon	7/19/15	9300 block of Norwood Court – report of person in neighboring yard looking for arrow; on arrival officers learned father and son looking for arrow shot over fence. Officers warned of ordinance for dangerous weapons.
Juvenile Problem	7/19/15	Weaver Lake Playfields – report of 15-20

		teenagers in park after hours; on arrival officers found that they were playing “night games”. They were advised of park hours and curfew for those under 18.
Theft from Auto	7/20/15	6400 block of Sycamore Lane – report of someone cutting the catalytic converters off two vehicles in parking lot; officers were advised this was 3 rd or 4 th time happening so extra patrol will be done.
Assist Other Agency	7/23/15	6200 block of Magnolia Lane – officers assisted in locating suspect in robbery in another city; officers arrived in area and located suspect who was then apprehended and turned over to other officers.

During this time frame there were 34 property damage traffic accidents and 7 property damage injury traffic accidents.
