

## MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 through January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016. TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Theft	1/15/16	12200 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – report of person taking items from business without paying; on arrival suspect arrested for shoplifting and released from scene.
Traffic Complaint	1/15/16	Bass Lake Road & I-494 – report of vehicle swerving all over the road; officers located vehicle, stopped it and arrested the driver for narcotics.
Assault	1/16/16	9400 block of Dunkirk Lane – report of persons being assaulted while in parking lot of business; on arrival victims did not want medical treatment or charges filed on known suspects.
Medical	1/17/16	9600 block of Grove Circle – report of person having chest pains along with sweating and a racing heart; on arrival officers provided care until paramedics arrived and cleared officers.
Suspicious Activity	1/17/16	13800 block of Grove Drive – report of suspicious occupied vehicle parked in lot of business late at night; officers made contact and person was using WiFi of business and would leave.
Animal Complaint	1/17/16	11800 block of 73 <sup>rd</sup> Avenue – report of dog left in vehicle at business for over an hour; on arrival officer located vehicle with dog that was in imminent danger because of cold (7 below zero). Owner came out and advised of state statute and left the scene.
Medical	1/18/16	10800 block of Zopfi Way – report of juvenile having breathing problems and an inverted chest; on arrival officers provided oxygen until transported to hospital by ambulance.
Weapons	1/18/16	8600 block of Terraceview Lane – report of neighbors point guns at each other in driveway; on arrival officers found air soft guns laying in driveway. Parties were advised on city ordinance regarding guns.
Appliance Fire	1/18/16	7700 block of Yucca Lane – report of dryer on

		fire; on arrival officers found flames inside dryer that were put out with extinguisher. Fire department arrived and cleared officers.
Animal Complaint	1/18/16	7200 block of Polaris Lane – report of dog left outside for over two hours in cold weather; officers made contact with homeowner who was not home and forgot about letting dog back in. Homeowner allowed officers to put in residence through unlocked rear door.
Open Door	1/19/16	13900 block of 77 <sup>th</sup> Avenue – report of neighbors garage door open for one whole day at neighbors residence; on arrival garage door open as well as door into residence unlocked. No sign of burglary. Officers secured inside door and shut garage door.
Theft From Auto	1/19/16	12600 block of 82 <sup>nd</sup> Avenue – report of items stolen from unlocked vehicle in parking lot of business; no suspects at this time.
Medical	1/20/16	9200 block of Blackoaks Lane – report of person unconscious; on arrival person blood sugar was low. Once paramedics arrived officers were cleared.
Medical	1/21/16	13500 block of Grove Drive – report of person having chest pains; on arrival officer provided oxygen until paramedics arrived for transport.
