UPDATED INFORMATION:

The victim of the pedestrian fatality on August 23, 2012, in Maple Grove has been positively identified. At this time her name is not being released until family members are notified. The Maple Grove Police Department is still investigating this incident.

INFORMATION:

On August 23, 2012, at approximately 01:36 a.m., the Maple Grove Police Department received a call of a pedestrian that was struck by a motor vehicle on Weaver Lake Road east of Main Street in Maple Grove. When officers responded to the scene they found a pedestrian victim deceased.

The Maple Grove Police Department has been unable to identify the victim and is looking for the public's assistance in identifying the victim.

The victim is a white female, approximately 5'4 tall, 35 to 40 years of age, and blonde shoulder length hair.

The Maple Grove Police Department is actively investigating the accident and is receiving assistance from the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office, Hennepin County Medical Examiner, and the Minnesota State Patrol.
