Medical	12/25/15	16500 block of 92 nd Avenue – report of person falling and hurting left shoulder; officers assisted paramedics for transport of person to hospital.
Animal Complaint	12/25/15	16000 block of 92 nd Avenue – report of three dogs locked in vehicle in parking lot; on arrival owner advised of ordinance violation.
Theft	12/25/15	17100 block of 80 th Place - report of two projectors stolen from yard; no suspects at this time.
Medical	12/26/15	6400 block of Xenium Lane – report of person having breathing problems; on arrival resident with portable oxygen tank that was low. Officers administered oxygen at high rate which relaxed and eased their breathing until North arrived for transport.

Welfare Check	12/31/15	9800 block of Alvarado Lane – report of a barefoot elderly male walking down the street, who appeared disoriented; on arrival officer's patrolled area, unable to locate the male. Another caller, found the male, who was transported to the hospital.
Medical	12/31/15	14700 block of Territorial Road – report of person having seizures; upon officer's arrival person out of seizure, medics arrived person had another seizure. Transported to hospital by ambulance.
Suspicious Activity	12/31/15	8200 block of Yellowstone Lane – report of someone trying to get into neighbors residence; on arrival made contact with party who was watching pet while homeowners were out of town.
