

MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of February 26th, 2016 through March 3rd, 2016. Please refer to City Web-Site Crime Mapping Section for additional details for the crimes of Burglary, Robbery, Arson, Theft and Vehicle Theft.

TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Suspicious Vehicle	2/26/16	6200 block of Magda Drive – report of a vehicle driving fast through a neighborhood, pulling into driveways then driving away; officers located vehicle and found it to be paper delivery.
Theft From Auto	2/26/16	9500 block of Garland Lane – report of someone entering an unlocked vehicle in a parking lot, currency taken; no suspects at this time.
Medical	2/27/16	16000 block of 78 th Place – report of person with severe back pain; on arrival with paramedics assisted person to the ambulance for transport.
Medical	2/27/16	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of a possible broken arm; on arrival officers assisted paramedics who then transported person to hospital.
Suspicious Person	2/27/16	9500 block of Niagara Lane – report of a person hiding in bushes at neighbors residence; on arrival person had left and officers could not locate anyone matching description.

House Fire	3/2/16	8900 block of Sycamore Lane – report of car fire inside attached garage; officers arrived primed fire hydrant. MG fire arrived and put out fire.
Suspicious Activity	3/2/16	8000 block of Forestview Lane – report of a vehicle parked in front of residence; officers made contact with driver, driver stated they pulled over to take phone calls.
Welfare Check	3/3/16	8300 block of Rice Lake Road – report of person sleeping in lobby with a ski mask on; officers made contact, person left with no incident.
Medical	3/3/16	9000 block of Garland Lane – report of a person who appeared confused; officers made contact, determined it was a diabetic reaction problem and they were transported to the hospital.
