



Maple Grove Fire-Rescue

Senior Citizen Smoke Alarm & Battery Replacement Program

The Maple Grove Fire Department (MGFD) has established a program to help seniors ensure that they have working smoke alarms in their home. MGFD will change out smoke alarm batteries **free of charge** thanks to a grant from ENERGIZER battery provided that the smoke alarms are less than 10 years old.

If your smoke alarms are 10 years or older, MGFD will provide information and guidance on purchasing new smoke alarms. Once you have purchased new smoke alarms MGFD will install them for you **free of charge**.

MGFD also has funds available to purchase new smoke alarms for seniors or mobility impaired citizens who are on fixed or limited incomes. In order to qualify at least one person in the household must be age 60 or older, or is disabled.

Net Income level is under \$23,075.00 for a one person household.

Net Income level is under \$26,375.00 for a two person household.

Funds are limited and available on a first come first serve basis.
