

MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of June 26th, 2015 through July 2nd, 2015. Please refer to City Web-Site Crime Mapping Section for additional details for the crimes of Burglary, Robbery, Arson, Theft and Vehicle Theft.

TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Theft	6/26/15	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of shoplifter detained at business; on officers arrival person was searched and drugs were recovered and person was eventually arrested.
Theft	6/26/15	17000 block of 72 nd Place – report of someone stealing two boat cushions out of boat parked in driveway totaling \$400 loss; officer found no suspect information or evidence for follow up.
Fire	6/26/15	11000 block of 95 th Avenue – report of a dumpster on fire behind business; on arrival dumpster fully engulfed and officers waited for the fire department to arrive to put out. Unknown how fire started at this time and no injuries.
Suspicious Activity	6/27/15	Elm Creek Blvd & Main Street – officer on routine patrol noticed vehicle stopped halfway in crosswalk and pedestrians had to walk behind or in front of vehicle in traffic; officer made contact and arrested person for DWI.
Damage to Property	6/27/15	10000 block of 102 nd Avenue – witness reported seeing vehicle parked on side of road and then backing up over a utility box and damaging it and leaving at high rate of speed; officer located tire tracks in lawn and put cover for box back on, no suspects found at this time.
Traffic Complaint	6/27/15	Brockton Lane & I-94 – report of driver all over the road and reporting party following; officer made contact with driver and was arrested for DWI.
Car Prowler	6/28/15	8300 block of Archer Lane – resident heard a bang and person swearing. After looking out they saw person by vehicle in driveway who took off running; no entry gained and nothing stolen. Numerous officers checked area and could not locate person.

Trespassing	6/28/15	Forestview Lane & Hemlock Lane – officer located vehicle parked in area and saw footprints into gravel pits; officer located person in dangerous area and cited them for trespassing.
Animal Welfare	6/28/15	7900 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of small dog left in vehicle for 30 minutes; on arrival officer checked temperature of 103.8 degrees. Owner finally came out and was informed of dangers to pet.
Theft From Auto	6/29/15	7000 block of Narcissus Lane – report of person taking items from unlocked vehicle in driveway; no evidence or suspects located.
Animal Welfare	6/29/15	8400 Block of Dunkirk Lane – report of dog locked in back of pickup truck with no water; on arrival temperature in truck was 94 degrees and all windows closed. Dog was removed and given water and then impounded at PUPS. Owner cited for incident.
Juvenile Complaint	6/29/15	12000 block of Weaver Lake Road – report of juveniles lighting fireworks and starting fire in garbage; fire out on arrival but officers found fire damage to table at park from fireworks. Juveniles located and case being investigated for cost to fix damage.
House Fire	6/30/15	6000 block of Merrimac Lane – report of possible house fire; on arrival officers found heaving smoke in residence and all persons and pets were out of home. MG Fire responded and found a pan on the stove to be on fire.
Slumper	7/1/15	7900 block of Main Street – report of person slumped over steering wheel and drooling; on arrival officers finally woke person who refused to get out of vehicle. Person was eventually arrested for obstruction and DWI.

During this period there were 32 property damage traffic accidents and 6 property damage traffic injury accident.
