
## Stroll - Walk - Run ENJOY!

### SHARE THE TRAIL

Etiquette for walkers:

- Walk on the far right side of the trail.
- If group walking, regularly check behind you for upcoming traffic and go to a single file when someone is trying to pass.
- If using headphones, keep volume soft enough to hear activity behind you.
- Keep dogs leashed/under restraint at all times.

Etiquette for bikers and in-line skaters:

- Bikers and skaters, yield to walkers.
- Control your speed. It is recommended to stay under 10 mph on a shared trail.
- When passing, use the left side of the trail announcing to walkers when you are about to pass. Proceed with extreme caution and slowed speed.
