


HIGHWAY 610 PRELIMINARY DESIGN PROJECT AND PROPOSED COUNTY ROAD EXTENSION



Project Information

Highway 610 is a vital east-west link for the growing northern suburbs – the construction of the final 2.5 mile segment of Highway 610 will connect I-94 in Maple Grove to Highway 169 in Brooklyn Park and serve as a relief valve for the heavily congested I-94. In addition, Highway 610 provides opportunities for continued commercial and industrial expansion along the corridor.

Public Information Meeting

You are invited to attend a public information meeting for the Highway 610 Preliminary Design Project in Maple Grove. At the meeting you will be able to learn about the Highway 610 preliminary design from approximately Elm Creek Boulevard to I-94 and the proposed County Road extension from I-94 to 97th Avenue North (County Road 30). Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT), Hennepin County, and City of Maple Grove staff will be available to answer questions and to receive input.
