

MAPLE GROVE POLICE NEWS

Following is a synopsis of some of the incidents that occurred in the City during the week of July 31st, 2015 through August 6th, 2015. Please refer to City Web-Site Crime Mapping Section for additional details for the crimes of Burglary, Robbery, Arson, Theft and Vehicle Theft.

TYPE OF INCIDENT	DATE	DESCRIPTION
Robbery	7/31/15	13000 block of 83 rd Way – report of business being robbed at gun point and employees put in freezer; on arrival officers put up perimeter and located possible suspect. Case still being investigated.
Theft From Auto	7/31/15	6900 block of Jonquil Court – report of suspects going into unlocked vehicle in driveway and stealing only cash; no suspects at this time.
Theft	8/1/15	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of person concealing items and trying to leave without paying; officers arrived and suspect arrested for theft.
Medical	8/1/15	12000 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – report of person falling and hitting head and then unconscious and seizing; on arrival victim still disoriented and pale. Victim transported by ambulance to hospital.
Damage to Property	8/2/15	9000 block of Ives Lane – report of rear passenger window shattered on vehicle in driveway; officers did not locate any reason for breakage, nothing taken from vehicle and no suspects.
Medical	8/2/15	7900 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of person falling off ladder and bleeding from head; on arrival officers applied gauze to control bleeding and was then transported to hospital.
Theft	8/3/15	8000 block of Wedgewood Lane – report of several males inside store concealing items and leaving without paying; officer made traffic stop on vehicle and arrested three suspects for theft.
Theft	8/3/15	12000 block of Weaver Lake Road – report of suspects stealing bikes from area; surveillance viewed and suspects identified. Officer doing follow up on case.
House Fire	8/4/15	6200 block of Alvarado Lane – neighbor

		reported house on fire in area; on officer arrival front side of home engulfed. Officers assisted MG fire with scene. Nobody injured, but major damage to residence.
Traffic Complaint	8/4/15	Weaver Lake Road & Zachary Lane – report of driver all over the road and going up on curbs; officers located and stopped the vehicle and made an arrest of driver for DWI and assault of an officer.
Suspicious Activity	8/4/15	6200 block of Ranier Lane – report of person hiding in bushes in area; on arrival officer's located person who was testing out his homemade Ghillie suite for hunting.
Damage to Property	8/5/15	17000 block of 62 nd Court – report of person finding several solar lights in yard broken over night; no suspects or leads for damage.
Theft	8/5/15	12000 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – report of two suspects each stealing one of a pair of shoes from business; officers located both suspects who were arrested for theft.
Medical	8/5/15	16000 block of 90 th Court – report of person unconscious; on arrival found person unresponsive but did have a pulse. Officers provided oxygen and victim responded. North paramedics transported person to hospital.
Vehicle Fire	8/6/15	County Road 30 & I-94; report of trailer of a semi on fire; on arrival officers assisted with scene and traffic control near fully engulfed trailer. Total loss of trailer and food products, but no injuries.
Damage to Property	8/6/15	6700 block of Yellowstone Lane – report of 12 solar lights broken in yard; no suspects or leads at this time.
Stolen Vehicle	8/6/15	12000 block of Elm Creek Boulevard – report of vehicle being stolen from parking lot while owner inside store; on arrival officers did not locate any evidence or suspects and found vehicle was unlocked with keys inside.

During this time frame there were 37 property damage traffic accidents and 5 property damage injury traffic accidents.
