Dear Chairmen Lewis and Park Board Members,

Throughout the years, Maple Grove Parks and Recreation Board has supported Maple Grove Community Organization (MGCO) by waiving fees for the use of park properties during MGCO sponsored events. This support is very much appreciated by all of our members. As in years past, we are requesting the same continued support. We are grateful for the opportunity to offer family-oriented activities at the Maple Grove Community Center, trails and parks. We have requested the use of the following locations with the understanding we need to be flexible in our planning.

MGCO would like to request the Maple Grove Parks and Recreation Board waive fees for the following Maple Grove Community Center rental areas:

- Maple Grove Days Events
  - July 12 – banquet room for volunteer training
  - July 13 – banquet kitchen area, for Rotary to assemble sandwiches for the parade (3pm-8pm tentative).
  - July 14 – room 133, storage, senior center, gym, banquet room, parking lots for setup/prep
  - July 15-16 – entire Community Center building, parking lots, green space, volleyball courts, lazy river, skate plaza for multiple Maple Grove Days events
  - July 16-17 – volleyball courts for volleyball tournament
- Breakfast/Lunch with Santa
  - December 2 – banquet room for evening setup (approx. 6pm)
  - December 3- Banquet Room, Senior Center, and maze Lobby Area for event

MGCO would like to request the Maple Grove Parks and Recreation Board waive fees for the following Special Use Permits:

- July 14 – Central Park and Lakeview Knolls pickleball courts for pickleball tournament

- July 15 – Central Park lawn, promenade and pergola for diaper derby and kiddy parade; Town Green bandshell for kids' movie
- July 16 – Town Green bandshell for entertainment, Central Park Great Lawn/Skate Loop for Business Expo, corn hole tournament and food trucks, Central Park trail for Kids' Run, Lion's Pavilion for Corn Feed, Rice Lake trail/Freedom Field for Rice Lake Classic, Weaver Lake fishing pier for free fishing clinic

MGCO would like to request permission to sell food, beverages, novelty items and participation fees for activities (all activities, games and registration fees) offered during Maple Grove Days. In addition, permission and approval to sell alcoholic beverages at our beer garden in the Community Center parking lot and Central Park beer garden.

MGCO would like to request permission to offer bingo on Saturday, July 16 during Maple Grove Days. MGCO will be responsible for obtaining all gambling license from the State of Minnesota and approval by the City of Maple Grove. The license will be obtained in Maple Grove Community Organization's name.

July 13-17 will be the 34<sup>th</sup> annual celebration of Maple Grove Days. There is an anticipated attendance of over 30,000 residents and visitors expected. The festival provides the perfect platform to showcase Maple Grove and gives exposure to staples like the Community Center, Central Park, Town Green, and city parks and trails to Maple Grove citizens and out of town visitors. Our mission for the 2022 celebration is to continue the tradition of a festival that our community leaders and citizens proudly look forward to year after year, while expanding our horizons to creatively bring the Maple Grove, and surrounding communities, together. We strive to present activities for all ages, throw a high quality hometown celebration, and gain widespread participation from the numerous organizations our citizens have grown to know and love. Maple Grove Days grows community involvement, Maple Grove pride, and develops the spirit of volunteerism in our city.

The Halloween Family Fun Event at Weaver Lake Park in October and Breakfast/Lunch with Santa in December both have been successful events over the years. These events offer families the opportunity to engage in fun holiday activities featuring dressing up in Halloween costumes and sharing their wishes with Santa Claus. These events are fun for the whole family! Each year, even in the midst of the pandemic, over 500 people have participated in these events.
