PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

The Maple Grove City Council previously approved a version of the revised Joint and Cooperative Agreement for the Formation and Administration of the Anoka-Hennepin Narcotics and Violent Crimes Task Force on July 15, 2019.

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

A motion to approve the revised Joint and Cooperative Agreement for the Formation and Administration of the Anoka-Hennepin Narcotics and Violent Crimes Task Force and authorize the mayor, city administrator, and chief of police to sign the agreement.

The Anoka-Hennepin Narcotics and Violent Crimes Task Force advisory board approved the revised joint and cooperative agreement at their February 3, 2022, board meeting. The revised agreement is needed to clarify the responsibilities of the team leader as defined on page 5. The agreement was modified to reflect that the team leader provides oversight and not supervision. The change was requested to better reflect the responsibility of the position for the agency that provides the personnel for the position.

As of February 3, 2022, this agreement replaces the previous Joint Powers agreement between the parties, which began July 1, 2019.
