Hi Ken

Just wanted to follow up on our conversation from a week ago regarding Northglen and the sound study:

You have noted that this is only preliminary discussion however, they have been monitoring the noise level and the levels seem to indicate that some type of noise mitigation is recommended.

The possible options talked about so far, which would need to come for a vote with the city council and the owners that would benefit from this, seem to be to:

- Install a sound wall in the same location as the current walking path and then the walking path moved to the south some.
 - Leave everything where it is right now and install some additional greenery along that are to better buffer the noise

- Ken – the Northglen Board discussed this the Association’s 1st choice would be to have a sound barrier fence and it would need to be put between the walking path and the Association building. (a good example one like this would be along Weaver Lake Road.) Also as another follow-up, please pursue the City council not to vote on this issue and just the affected Association owners.

Thank you Ken and please kept me informed of where this process is going forward.
