

RESOLUTION NO. 22-102

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CITY COUNCIL’S ACCEPTANCE BY MOTION OF A DONATION FROM THE FIREHOUSE SUBS PUBLIC SAFETY FOUNDATION OF THERMAL IMAGING CAMERAS TO THE MAPLE GROVE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 465.03 authorizes the City to accept gifts and donations for the benefit of its citizens by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Maple Grove Fire Department (“MGFD”) uses thermal imaging cameras during emergency events;

WHEREAS, MGFD applied for an equipment grant in the amount of \$42,335 from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation for the purchase of new thermal imaging cameras for each of Maple Grove’s five fire stations;

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation awarded the MGFD five MSA Evolution 6000 Thermal Imaging Cameras;

WHEREAS, during its meeting of May 16, 2022, the City Council passed an oral motion on a 4-0 vote to accept the donation and delivery of the thermal imaging equipment to the MGFD;

WHEREAS, acceptance of such a donation requires a resolution by a two-thirds majority of the City Council, setting forth the terms in full;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF MAPLE GROVE, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Consistent with its oral motion on May 16, 2022, and ratifying the same, MGFD is hereby authorized to accept donation of five MSA Evolution 6000 Thermal Imaging Cameras, valued at \$42,335, from Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation for use in the City’s five fire stations, and to issue receipt acknowledging such donation as may be appropriate.
