AGENDA ITEM: Approval of State of Minnesota General Obligations Bond Proceeds Grant Agreement – Construction Grant for the North Metro Regional Public Safety Training Facility Maple Grove Project

PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

On June 3, 2019, the City Council approved Resolution No. 19-076 authorizing staff to prepare and submit a request to the Minnesota State Legislature for 2020 Capital Budget Request for bonding funds for the expansion of the Maple Grove North Metro Range and to adopt Resolution No. 19-076 in support of the North Metro Range expansion project, including the City's request for bond funds under Minn. Stat. § 16A.86.

On December 7, 2020, the City Council approved two professional services contract agreements with architect LEO A DALY for design and engineering services and RJM Construction for construction manager services and to direct the Mayor and City Administrator to execute the agreements, subject to final review by the City Attorney.

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

Motion to approve Resolution No. 22-104 authorizing the approval of the State of Minnesota General Obligations Bond Proceeds Grant Agreement – Construction Grant for the North Metro Regional Public Safety Training Facility Maple Grove Project with an effective date of June 20, 2022 and for the Mayor and City Administrator to execute the agreement.

The City of Maple Grove was awarded \$3.5 million in state bond funds during the October 5, 2020 Minnesota legislative special session for the expansion of the North Metro Range (NMR) regional public safety training facility. At the December 21, 2020 regular meeting the City Council approved two professional services contracts for the design, engineering, and

construction of the NMR expansion project. The project is currently underway with substantial completion anticipated for December 2022 and full completion by March 2023.

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety is the state agency responsible for administering the \$3.5 million of state bond funds to the City of Maple Grove through a state grant agreement. Police and finance department staff worked with a Department of Public Safety grant coordinator to finalize a grant agreement. Upon approval by the City Council, the grant agreement will be effective June 20, 2022. The City of Maple Grove will have access to the \$3.5 million bond funds upon execution of the grant agreement. Finance department staff will work with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety grant coordinator to process bond fund disbursement requests.

City Attorney Justin Templin reviewed the NMR state grant agreement.
