RESOLUTION APPROVING METROPOLITAN COUNCIL CLEAN WATER FUND GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Grove has been approved by Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES) for participation in the 2022-2024 Water Efficiency Rebate Program; and

WHEREAS, MCES and the Clean Water Fund provides grant funding for establishing a water demand reduction program to implement measures to reduce water demand to ensure the reliability and protection of drinking water supplies; and

WHEREAS, grant funding will be used to establish a local rebate program to incentivize residents and business owners of Maple Grove to reduce water demand for irrigation purposes. Residents and business owners will be able to apply for a rebate on purchases of approved replacement irrigation water system controllers and spray sprinkler bodies; and

WHEREAS, Maple Grove will receive a grant in the amount of \$45,000. The agreement requires a 20% (\$11,250) match by the city for a total budget of \$56,250 for the two-year rebate program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Grove, Minnesota:

- 1. The Metropolitan Council Clean Water Fund Grant Agreement is hereby approved.
- 2. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement.
