ISD 279 and City of Maple Grove
Fernbrook Fields

PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

At their May 4, 2020 meeting Council approved the First Amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement to expand school use of the Fernbrook Fields Complex

At their September 17, 2018 meeting Council approved a Joint Powers Agreement related to the Fernbrook Fields Complex.

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

Motion to approve the Second Amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement with the City of Maple Grove and the Independent School District 279 modifying the ISD 279 use time as previously intended with the First Amendment.

COMMENTS:

The City and Park Board have a long-standing relationship with the School District through numerous joint powers arrangements that greatly benefit both parties with the responsible management of public resources.

In 2020, at the infancy of COVID, staff was working with the school district on providing additional access to the sports dome for residents to walk. With that the district in turn would have additional access to Fernbrook Fields. It was recently discovered that the First Amendment had some ISD 279 field use time errors. This Second Amendment rectifies those errors. The School District agreed with the modifications and approved the amendment at their May 24, 2022 School Board meeting.
