

RESOLUTION 22-117

APPOINTING PRECINCT ELECTION JUDGES AND ABSENTEE BALLOT BOARD
ELECTION JUDGES FOR THE AUGUST 9, 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION
AND THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022 GENERAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, Minnesota Election Law 204B.21 requires that persons serving as election judges be appointed by City Council at least 25 days before the election.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Maple Grove City Council that the individuals named in Exhibit A, and on file in the office of the city clerk be appointed as the City of Maple Grove precinct judges and absentee ballot board election judges for the August 9, 2022 primary election and the November 8, 2022 general election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Maple Grove City Council also appoints other individuals and members appointed to the Hennepin County Absentee Ballot Board as authorized under Minn. Stat. 204B.21, subd. 2 under the direction of the election manager to serve as members of the Maple Grove Absentee Ballot Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the city clerk is with this, authorized to make substitutions or additions as deemed necessary.
