RESOLUTION NO. 23-018

RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR A CORRIDORS OF COMMERCE APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT AN AUXILIARY LANE TO WESTBOUND I-94 BETWEEN THE HEMLOCK LANE AND WEAVER LAKE ROAD INTERCHANGES

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Department of Transportation is currently accepting applications for state funding of transportation projects on the trunk highway (TH) systems through their 2022 Corridors of Commerce Solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the Corridors of Commerce Program provides dedicated, discretionary funding for transportation investments in state highway projects that directly and indirectly foster economic growth for the state through the provisioning of construction jobs, enabling of goods to be transported through a commerce friendly network of corridors, and providing additional mobility to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Freeway System Interchange Study completed in 2020 by Minnesota Department of Transportation and the Metropolitan identified cost-effective solutions to deficiencies in the Fish Lake Interchange; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rogers is seeking funds to construct a modified version of one such improvement that adds an auxiliary lane to westbound I-94 between the Hemlock Lane and Weaver Lake Road interchanges; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvement will not only improve traffic flow and safety elements within the Fish Lake interchange by eliminating the bottleneck created by the existing four- to three-lane inside merge between westbound I-94 and northbound I-494, but freight mobility and reliability along the I-94 corridor – which is arguably one of the most important Tier 1 Truck Corridors in Minnesota and the Upper Midwest – will also be significantly improved; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Grove, Minnesota that the City of Maple Grove supports and approves the City of Rogers' application for MnDOT's 2022 Corridors of Commerce funds to construct an auxiliary lane to westbound I-94 between the Hemlock Lane and Weaver Lake Road interchanges.
