**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
A POLICE TRAINING FACILITY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement for bids, eleven (11) bids were received for the construction services and one (1) bid was received for the range equipment for the Police Training Facility; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Grove, Minnesota:

1. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into construction contracts with Donlar Construction of St. Paul, Minnesota in the name of the City of Maple Grove for the purchase of construction services for the Police Training Facility per the project drawings and specifications on file in the office of the City Clerk.
2. In addition, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Caswell International of Minneapolis, Minnesota in the name of the City of Maple Grove to purchase the range equipment for the Police Training Facility according to the specifications on file in the office of the City Clerk.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to return forthwith to all bidders the deposits made with their bids, except that the deposits of the successful bidder and the next lowest bidder shall be retained until a contract has been signed.


