PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

Council, at their June 20, 2022 meeting, adopted Resolution No. 22-112 ordering CSAH 101 – 73rd Avenue to 83rd Avenue, Project No. 22-10, approving plans and authorizing advertisement for bids.

Council, at their August 1, 2022 meeting, adopted Resolution No. 22-127 rejecting bids for CSAH 101 – 73rd Avenue to 83rd Avenue, Project No. 22-10.

Council, at their January 3, 2023 meeting, adopted Resolution No. 23-008 re-authorizing bids for CSAH 101 – 73rd Avenue to 83rd Avenue, Project No. 22-10.

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 23-025 accepting bid for CSAH 101 – 73rd Avenue to 83rd Avenue, Project No. 22-10.

COMMENTS:

The proposed improvements are best described in two project segments. From 73rd Avenue to 78th Avenue, the roadway will be built to a full urban section, including turn lanes, curb and gutter, storm sewer system, and trails along both sides, as indicated in Attachment C. From 78th Avenue to 83rd Avenue, the existing pavement will be reconstructed in a rural section that will match existing lane configuration. Where turn lanes exist, they will be replaced in kind. These improvements are shown in more detail on Attachment D.

Funding for the project will be largely from the City's Trunk Transportation Fund and Municipal State Aid Account. Hennepin County is contributing \$1,000,000 toward the project through a forthcoming Cooperative Construction Agreement. Hennepin County's cost participation in this project is fixed, and not subject to their typical Cost Sharing Policy.

Bids were received for CSAH 101 – 73rd Avenue to 83rd Avenue, Project No. 22-10 on January 31, 2023 and have been tabulated and reviewed for consistency with the bidding requirements. The following bids were received complying with the advertisements:

The low bidder on the project was New Look Contracting, Inc. with a total base bid amount of \$3,909,183.25. This compares favorably to the engineer's estimate of \$3,589,993.00.

It is recommended that Council adopt the attached resolution accepting the low bid and awarding the contract to New Look Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$3,909,183.25.
