WHEREAS, the Maple Grove City Code Article VI, Section 10-151-10-156 allows for the establishment of lawful gambling in the City of Maple Grove; and

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota Gambling Control Division requires approval by the city in which the pull tab operation is to be established; and

WHEREAS, Maple Grove Crimson Football Athletic Club has provided information to the City of Maple Grove for a pull tab (paper and electronic), bar bingo, paddlewheel, electronic pull tabs, and electronic linked bingo operation at Rock Elm – At the Grove located in the City of Maple Grove; and

WHEREAS, the Maple Grove Crimson Football Athletic Club has signed a lease agreement with Paul Sarratori, the owner of the gambling premise, and has submitted a copy of said agreement to the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Maple Grove City Council approves the Maple Grove Crimson Football Athletic Club for a pull tab (paper and electronic), bar bingo, paddlewheel, electronic pull tabs, and electronic liked bingo operation to be located at 15641 Maple Grove Circle, Maple Grove, Minnesota.
