Ice Arena

Aquatics

- The pools continue to bring in record numbers. Revenue levels showed the highest January, and the 2nd highest for any non-summer month, since at least 2017. We continue to evaluate staffing levels and plan to adjust the availability of pool features to meet the requests of patrons as best as we safely can.
