AGENDA ITEM: Approval of the unmanned aerial system service agreement addendum to the Police Department Axon master service contract

PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

Approval of the agreement between Axon Enterprises Inc. and the Maple Grove Police Department at the February 1, 2021, regular city council meeting.

Public comment on the police use of an Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) and the draft Maple Grove Department UAS Policy No. 606 at the June 20, 2022, regular city council meeting.

RECOMMENDED COUNCIL ACTION:

Motion to approve and authorize the chief of police to execute the three-year UAS service agreement addendum to the master service agreement between Axon Enterprises Inc. and the Maple Grove Police Department to add AXON AIR software support for the police department's UAS program.

COMMENTS: Adam Lindquist, Commander, Patrol Division

AXON AIR is a software system required to properly manage the police department's UAS program. The software system includes a licensing agreement, advanced streaming, data integrations, and UAS pilot data. The AXON AIR system was selected because it can fully integrate with the police department's body-worn and in-squad camera video data management system. AXON AIR ensures proper compliance with all statutory requirements for data use, management, and auditing required by state and federal law.

The three-year agreement total cost is \$14,050.24. The annual contract cost for 2023 and 2024, or years one and two, is \$4,683.41 for each year and will be paid utilizing the police criminal forfeiture account. The contract cost for 2025, or year three, is \$4,683.42 and will be budgeted from police general fund dollars.

City Attorney Justin Templin reviewed and approved the service agreement.
