

ORDINANCE NO. 23-22

CITY OF MAPLE GROVE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MAPLE GROVE CITY CODE 26-34 and 26-92 TO CONFORM TO STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS FOR ORGANICS RECYCLING

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAPLE GROVE DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS

A. Maple Grove City Code Section 26-34 is hereby amended as set forth below to add the underlined language and delete the language shown in ~~striketrough~~ as follows:

Sec. 26-34. Collection and disposal of recyclables and yard waste.

(a) *Generally.* The collection, removal and disposal of recyclables and yard waste shall be supervised by the city, which shall have the power to establish the time, method and routes of service and to make recycling mandatory. Special times for large item pickup may ~~also~~ be established.

...

(g) *Licensing of haulers.* It is unlawful to collect, haul, or convey recyclable materials, organic recyclables, or yard waste from any premises in the city, other than from one's own domicile or place of business, without a valid license therefor, and each vehicle so used and each hauler shall be licensed for such activity. The provisions of article IV of this chapter shall apply to licenses and licensees regulated by this subsection and to recyclables. Haulers licensed under this section shall not impose a greater charge on residents who recycle (including organic recyclables) than on residents who do not recycle.

B. Maple Grove City Code Section 26-92 is hereby amended as set forth below to add the underlined language and delete the language shown in ~~striketrough~~ as follows:

Sec. 26-92. License required.

It is unlawful to collect, haul or convey refuse from any premises in the city, other than from one's own domicile, without a valid license ~~therefor~~. Each such vehicle so used must be licensed for such activity. Haulers licensed under this section shall not impose a greater charge on residents who recycle (including organic recyclables) than on residents who do not recycle.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. Following its passage and publication as required by law, this Ordinance shall be in full force and in effect as of **January 1, 2024.**
