

# ELECTRICAL LICENSING AND INSPECTION



This handout is intended only as a guide and is based in part on the 2020 Minnesota State Building Code, Maple Grove City ordinances, and good building practice. While every attempt has been made to insure the correctness of this handout, no guarantees are made to its accuracy or completeness. Responsibility for compliance with applicable codes and ordinances falls on the permit applicant. For specific questions regarding code requirements, refer to the applicable codes or contact your local Building Department.

## ELECTRICAL LICENSING AND INSPECTION

The City of Maple Grove Building Department conducts inspections of electrical work within the city. All work must be done by and permits are only issued to licensed electrical contractors, with the exception that an owner of a single family residence may do electrical work and may obtain permits for work conducted by the homeowner provided they occupy that dwelling.
