FOR YOUR INFORMATION

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of specific construction scheduling information concerning the street reconstruction project. Full scale work will begin NLT AUGUST 1st as a result of work schedule change based on site conditions ahead of schedule. The overall schedule from the contractor will be placed on the website once submitted by the contractor and accepted by the City. Work will progress until complete during the month of October.

The streets will see a couple of permanent changes.

- The city is removing the green zone in the cul-de-sac areas as they prevent the City's fire trucks and other delivery trucks from navigating the cul-de-sacs without driving over the curbs.
- The central road island at 67th Pl and Evergreen Ln is also being removed to allow for snow plows to effectively plow the road without riding up on the curb to do so.

Expect to see work beginning possibly this week with the road being reclaimed (ground up) in preparation of the watermain replacement if the equipment is available. We will post flyers on your doors for watermain shutoff/temporary water & driveway closure notifications. CenterPoint Energy will also be in the area at the same time replacing your gas main and home service connection which has triggered this early start for your phase.

COMMUNICATIONS

We have a great project team with the city staff, our inspectors, the contractors, and the residents. We can only maintain that through effective communication. If you have any concerns of issues with the project, please contact the project coordinator Joseph Bzdok so we can work to correct or mitigate the issues as rapidly as possible.

We also have a project page on the city website that has all the project information, mailings, maps, and updates as the project progresses, this can be accessed at the City webpage->Departments Dropdown->Engineering. Then select the street reconstruction link on the left and select your project 2022-01 in the center of the page. Once on the page you can sign up for automatic updates anytime new items are posted to the website.
