

2022 HUNTING RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

LANDOWNER PERMISSION

You and landowner/lessee must complete the permit application together. If you get permission from a lessee, you need to know the name of the landowner leasing the land.

HUNTER ORIENTATION

The hunting orientation class became available for the first time in 2020 via video link on the Maple Grove Police Department hunting web page. ***You must attend/view a Maple Grove Hunter Orientation class every other year. Therefore, if you viewed this class in 2021, then you do not need to view it in 2022. However, the 2020 video link is once again available for those who need to view it to obtain current hunting privileges.***

You must include your signature and date on the permit verifying when you watched the video.

Please note: There will be a 3 - 5 business day wait for the issuance on all goose permits for the required criminal history checks.

Information on each application is subject to verification. Therefore, if there is a question, delay of 3-5 days should be expected before issuance.

HUNTING SURVEY

Any hunter failing to complete and return the required survey (deer, turkey and/or goose) by February 1, 2023 is subject to administrative sanction including and up to revocation of hunting privileges for all future hunts.

DEER HUNTING

Season:

- Archery: follows MN DNR season dates

City Permit: To obtain a city deer hunting permit you must have, or do the following:

- Possess a 2022 Minnesota Deer license
- Possess a landowner/lessee permission slip
- View the online video of the Maple Grove Hunter's Orientation/Safety class and sign/date your permit, unless you viewed a Maple Grove Hunter Orientation class in 2021.
- Show proof of possessing a Firearms Safety Certificate, Apprentice Hunter validation, a previous hunting license with a valid firearms safety indicator or other evidence of successfully completing a hunter safety course to obtain a permit to hunt in Maple Grove.
- Pay \$15.00 permit fee

Registering Deer:

- Every deer killed through hunting **MUST** be reported to Detective Dominic Wareham of the Maple Grove Police Department within 12 hours of the kill. **Failure to comply will result in automatic revocation of hunting privileges in Maple Grove.** Simply call Det. Wareham at 763-494-6196, and leave a message informing him of the date/time, location it was harvested, sex of deer, and adult or fawn. You **MUST ALSO** register all harvested deer with the MN DNR website or at a Big Game Registration station (see mndnr.gov for more information).

Miscellaneous Deer Regulations:

- Have in possession, at all times, your city-hunting permit
- We suggest placing a copy of city hunting permit on your vehicle's dashboard when you are hunting
- **Complete and return Hunting Survey by February 1, 2023**

TURKEY HUNTING

Seasons:

- Fall turkey: follows MN DNR season dates
- Spring turkey: follows MN DNR season dates

City Permit: To obtain city turkey hunting permit you must do the following:

- Possess a landowner/lessee permission slip
- View the online video of the Maple Grove Hunter Orientation/Safety Class and sign/date your permit unless you viewed a 2021 Maple Grove Hunter Orientation/Safety Class
- Show proof of possessing a Firearms Safety Certificate, Apprentice Hunter validation, a previous hunting license with a valid firearms safety indicator or other evidence of successfully completing a hunter safety course to obtain a permit to hunt in Maple Grove.
- Pay \$15.00 permit fee

Registering Turkey:

- Every person who takes a wild turkey must register the bird **within 24 hours** of taking the turkey.
- You may now register by three methods: at a registration station, by phone, or by Internet. (see mndnr.gov for more information)

Miscellaneous Turkey Regulations:

- Have in possession, at all times, your city-hunting permit
- We suggest placing a copy of city hunting permit on your vehicle's dashboard when you are hunting
- **Complete and return Hunting Survey by February 1, 2023**

GOOSE HUNTING

Seasons:

- Early Canada Goose season: follows MN DNR season dates
- Waterfowl season opener: follows MN DNR season dates

City Permit:

To obtain city goose hunting permit you must do the following:

- Possess a landowner/lessee permission slip
- View the online video of the Maple Grove Hunter Orientation/Safety Class and sign/date your permit unless you viewed a 2021 Maple Grove Hunter Orientation/Safety Class
- Show proof of possessing a Firearms Safety Certificate, Apprentice Hunter validation, a previous hunting license with a valid firearms safety indicator or other evidence of successfully completing a hunter safety course to obtain a permit to hunt in Maple Grove.
- Pay \$10.00 permit fee

Miscellaneous Goose Regulations:

- Have in possession, at all times, your city-hunting permit
- We suggest placing a copy of city hunting permit on your vehicle's dashboard when you are hunting
- **Complete and return Hunting Survey by February 1, 2023**

To hunt the Goose Lake area hunters shall:

- Hunt over water adjacent to the property they have permission to hunt (hunters may not hunt elsewhere on the lake)
- Shoot only over open water, not towards homes.

***Reminder:** There will be a 3-5 day wait for the issuance on all goose permits for the required criminal history checks.
