RE: Copper Marsh and Hidden Meadows Area Street Rehabilitation Project No. 2023-02

Dear Maple Grove resident:

The City of Maple Grove awarded the contract on the above project to GMH Asphalt, Inc. on April 17, 2023.

The project includes:

- Removal and replacement of concrete curb and gutter, bike trail and bituminous street surface.
- Installation of a 2-foot wide concrete apron on each driveway entrance as well as yard restoration.
- Installation of watermain and service as well as sanitary and storm sewer improvements.
- Replacement of private utilities.

The project will be completed in three phases. Construction hours are 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

- Monday to Friday and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturdays.
- Phase 1 is planned to start May 8th or May 15th.

Mailboxes:

- U.S. Postal Regulations require the installation of temporary mailboxes in a cluster at an easily accessible location for postal workers and residents.
- Permanent mailboxes will be removed and stored alongside each residents' garage.
- Any mailbox repair or replacement is the residents' responsibility.

Sprinkler systems, underground pet containment systems and special concerns:

- Irrigation systems within 3 feet of the curb will likely be damaged. The contract requires repairs be made to any system at no cost to the homeowner.
- Please refrain from lawn watering as it will delay or complicate the project.
- If not done previously, email streetrehab@maplegrovern.gov to inform staff of sprinkler systems, underground pet containment systems or any special concerns including accessibility for older adults or any person with a disability.

Garbage and recycling collection:

- Collection day is not affected; bins must be brought to street by 7 a.m.
- Label your garbage and recycling bin lids with name and address.
- If bin access is difficult, the contractor will assist haulers with collection.

Access, parking, and driveway restoration:

- Access to driveways will be limited during portions of the construction.
- Please refrain from parking on the street during construction hours.
- The contractor will place notices on/around your front door at least 24 hours prior to when the driveway will be inaccessible. Parking instructions will be included.

Sod restoration:

- Sod that is disturbed during construction will be replaced.
- The contractor will maintain the sod for 30 days. Homeowners are encouraged to water the sod to assist in growth. Exception to the City watering restrictions are typically granted in order to establish new sod.

Safety:

- For everyone's safety, please stay out of the work area and away from equipment at all times.
- Please be patient and alert during the construction process.

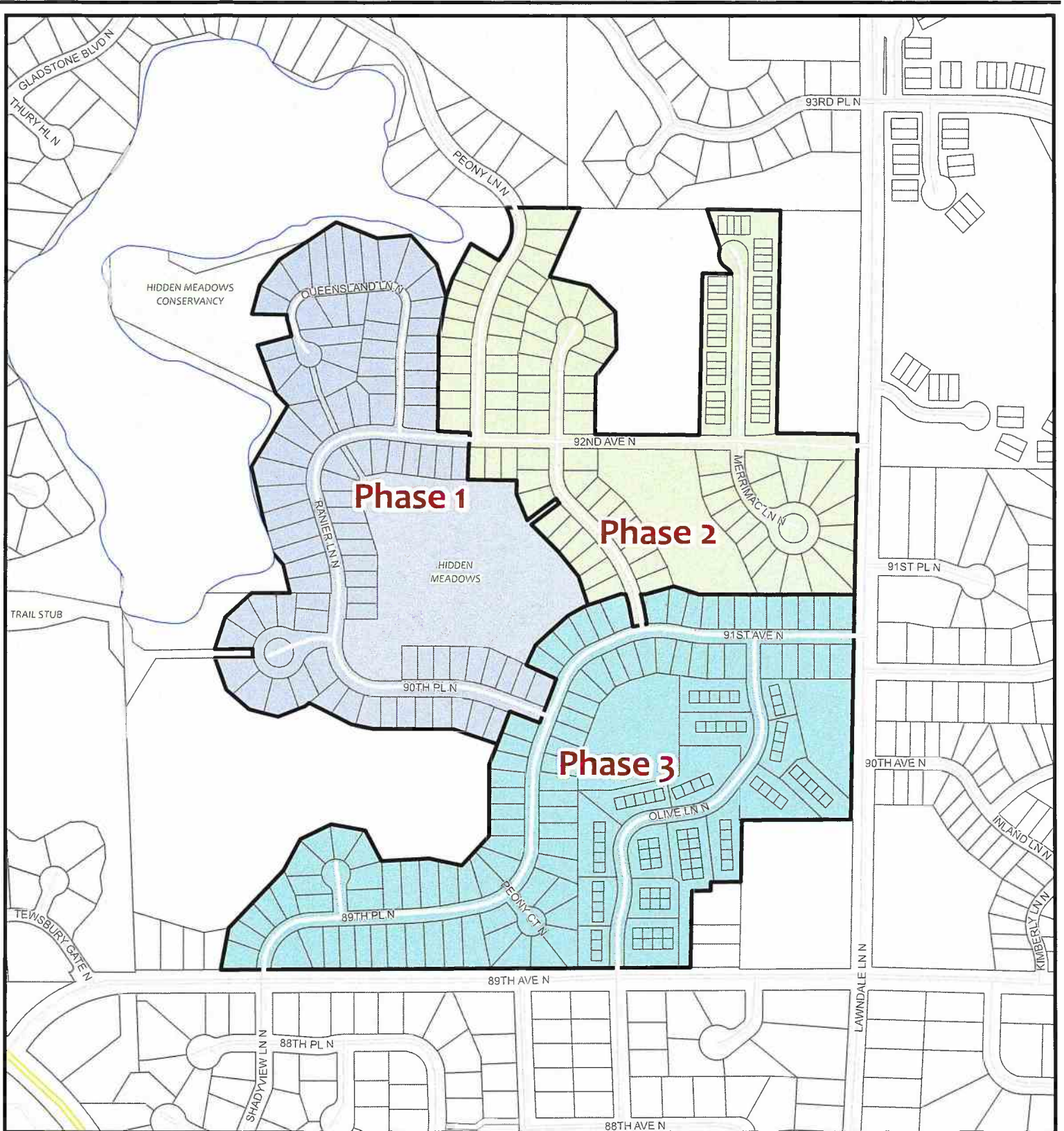
