Species	Initial height	Sun/shade	Features	Mature height	Mature spread
Firefall Maple	5-6'	●	Rich green summer leaves turn crimson red in fall.	50'	35'
Heritage Oak	5-6'	●	It has a pyramidal form with dark thick, leathery leaves.	60'	40'
Ironwood	5-6'	●●	Dark green foliage turns lemon yellow in the fall.	50'	25'
Northern Red Oak	5-6'	●	Fast Growing. Red fall color.	75'	45'
Quaking Aspen	6'	●●	Has smooth, greenish-white to cream bark on long narrow trunk. Provides stunning yellow fall color.	65'	30'
River Birch Clump	6'	●	Dark green summer foliage becomes yellow in fall. Reddish brown exfoliating bark creates interest in winter landscape.	40'	15'
Dakota Pinnacle Birch	6'	●●	Beautiful bark, leaf out early, and has buttery yellow fall color.	35'	10'
Prairie Fire Crab	6'	●	Beautiful spring bloom, and autumn fruits that persist into winter.	20'	20'
Pink Diamond Hydrangea	6'	●●	Green foliage throughout the season with white flowers at the ends of branches from midsummer to late fall.	8'	6'
Balsam Fir	1-2'	●●	Symmetrical spire-like crown, shining dark green in color.	60'	25'
